


Normwall of the Kemp chapel: For Sir Robert Kemp of Gissing who was born at Walsingham Abbey 2nd. Feb. 1627, died 26 Sept. 1710, in the B3rd. year of thic age. He first married Mary dav. of Thos. Kerniage by Susan his wife. She was born in London Feb. 1631. They were married 15th. July 1650 & she died in June 1655. They had a son and two davs., born and christened which died young. He marr. 2nd. Mary daw. of John Sone of Whoston, Suff. by Mary daw. of Wim. Dade. The was born 6 April 1637. They were marr 28 Nov. 1657. She died 29 July 1705 at Ubbeston. By her he had 3 sons and 2 daws. There is a blank shield at top of the monument.




Kerry quarting butteryn, impalan Chilford.

Westwall, Kemp Chapel:




Farrer. Monument to Sir Robert Kemp of Ubbeston Hall, Suffolk, who died 25th. Nov. 1761 aged 60. Also of his brother, the Rev. Thomas Kemp, who died 5th. March 1761. Also of Sir John Kemp, son of the Rev. Thomas Kemp, who died 16th. January 1761 ae. 17yrs., and of Mary, his sister who died 17 True 1784 ae. 25.



For Sir Robert Kemp, Bart., of Ubbeston Hall, in Suffolk, who died 18th. Dec. 1734 ac. 08, having married first, Letitia, aav. of Robert King of Thurlow, Suff.; secondly, Elizabeth, only dav. & heiress of John Brand of Edwarston; thirdy, Martha, dav. of William Blackwell of Mortlake, Surrey; and lastly, Amy, Medav. of Richard Philips. and relict of John Burrough of Gipps, Suffolk.



For Robert Kemp late of Gissing, only son and child of Richard Kemp of Gissing and Alice Cockernam (dav. of Philip Cockernam of Hampstead, Middlesex esq. sometime officer to King Edw. VI & Queen Mary in Their Custome House at London). He married Dorothy Herris, sole dav. of Armor Herris of Crixeth Essex esq. by whom he had 8 sons & 3 davs (7\$2 surviving). At 47 years of age died 23. Oct. 1612, having been wedded 17 yrs. There is a blamk shield at the bottom of the monument
